Policy Statement

- The policy of the company is to develop and operate a management system and working practices that make proper provision for the protection of the environment.
- The company is committed to working to all environmental codes of practice and to take account of updates to the codes as appropriate.
- Environmental impact assessments will be made on all operations.
- The transportation and disposal of all materials and waste will be done in a responsible manner, with due regard for environmental considerations and obligations.
- Employees will receive awareness briefings and training when appropriate.
- The company will conduct audits on its environmental protection performance, and expect its suppliers and sub-contractors to do the same.
- All documents relating to policy and procedures will be kept in the office Environmental Protection File.

Operating Policy

1. The Managing Director is responsible for Environmental Protection.
2. The Managing Director will be responsible for the implementation and control of the Environmental Protection systems.
3. The Managing Director is responsible for ensuring that all the relevant codes of practice are available and up-to-date.
4. The Managing Director should identify the training needs of staff and operatives and ensure proper training and instruction is given.
5. All staff and operatives have responsibilities to:
 - Apply the relevant Codes of Practice, procedures and systems appropriate to the operations being undertaken.
 - Report any environmental accident and assist in any investigations or future preventative measures.
 - Co-operate as necessary in assisting to minimise the risk of environmental accident by reducing waste and taking any precautionary measures that may be appropriate.
 - All documents relating to policy and procedures will be kept in the office Environmental Protection File.
